### **Equitable Access to Instruction**

Based on our distance learning survey, it has been noted that 100% of our students have an electronic device and internet access that will allow them to access our distance learning portal. Within the first 5 days we will access our curriculum via google classroom. After the initial five day period, we will transition to the Acellus learning portal. Teachers will monitor daily student progress and all students will be required to meet the mandated percentage requirement in order to receive proper credit for the course.

### **Special Education and Related Services**

In the event that we need to transition to home instruction an IPP will be developed for all students with special needs. The IPP will contain proper accommodations that will modify the program that is required by the Board of Trustees for promotion or graduation. Such measures will not be followed if the physician or basic child study team deems it detrimental. In regards to Policy 6173 Section E- If it is deemed a State of Emergency and/ or the student is confined due to COVID19, the Board of Trustees has waived the provision that a Certified SPED Teacher must visit twice a week and has concluded that the students will receive, a modified distance learning program to meet the goals set in their IPP.

### **School Nutrition Benefits and Services**

The Barack Obama Green Charter HS is a CEP school that is required to provide meals to all students regardless of their economic status. The Barack Obama Green Charter HS will provide “go-to-food” for students during potential school closing. We will prepare shelf stable food items that will be handed to the students a day prior to potential planned school closing. Each day of closure, a designated person will come to distribute food at the main entrance of the building. Our food service provider, Nu-Way Concessionaires, will remain open and will be flexible and accommodate any kind of meal service we will need.

### **Attendance**

In the event that The Barack Obama Green Charter HS transitions to our distance learning model, all students and instructional staff will be required to log into our distance learning portal by 9:00am each school day. Their log in stamp will count for daily attendance. It is required that students and staff log into the online portal for a minimum of four hours a day.

### **Board and Community Meetings**

It is the intent of the Board of Trustees to continue to have in person meetings that allow the public to attend until the Department of Health deems it unsafe to do such. At that time, the Board of Trustees will decide on a meeting style that will address normal governance procedures for The Barack Obama Green Charter District. Alternate meeting options can include but are not limited to: Conference Calls, Skype, and/or Video Chat for members of the Board of Trustees as well as the public.

### **Off-Site Professional Learning**

If The Barack Obama Green Charter HS is in session and a member of the staff is scheduled to attend a Professional Learning session off-site, we are inquiring if the vendor is offering a webinar in place of a face to face session. If a webinar is available, we are asking our staff to utilize that option. If the vendor is not offering a web based service we are asking our staff to reschedule the session until the State of Emergency is lifted.

### **Extracurricular Activities and Field Trips**

All Extracurricular activities and Field trips were cancelled as of March, 9, 2020 after Governor Murphy deemed New Jersey in a State of Emergency.
