BOGCHS WIFI Hotspot Contract

BOGCHS is offering a limited number of free wireless hotspot devices to students who do not have Internet access at home. This program enables students to “check out” Internet service for absolutely free. Both the device and monthly service fees are fully paid by the school. The pilot program is intended to help BOGCHS students access online resources at home to help bridge the digital divide and ensure educational equity. The borrowing limit is one device per household. This form must be completed by the parent/guardian prior to each time a device is signed out to the student. By signing this form, the parent/guardian agrees to assume all responsibility for equipment signed out to the student. A replacement fee of \$100 will be charged if the device is lost, damaged or not returned.

- Students and Parents/Guardians acknowledge that any issued device is and remains the property of BOGCHS. BOGCHS is loaning the device to the Student. The Student’s use of the device is a privilege and can be revoked at any time. The Student must return the device to BOGCHS at the end of the checkout period, or immediately upon the request of BOGCHS.
- Students will adhere to these terms each time the device is used.
- Students use of the device must comply with all applicable School Board Policies and Regulations including the Student Code of Conduct and the Acceptable Use Policy. The device is to be used for Educational purposes only.
- Students have no expectation of privacy in his/her use of the device. BOGCHS reserves the right to monitor the Student’s use of the device and to periodically inspect the device without prior notice.
- Students will report to School Personnel any incidents of inappropriate communications transmitted in any form using BOGCHS owned technology.
- Students will not alter, disfigure or deface the device or adhere stickers or other markings that cannot be completely removed by the Student prior to returning the device. Student’s will not cover up or remove any manufacturer or BOGCHS markings, numbers, letters or insignia.
- Students are responsible for the reasonable care of the device. Students agree to transport and use the issued device in a school provided case at all times. Students should take care not to drop the device, get it wet, leave it outdoors or in extreme weather conditions, or use it near food or drink. Students may clean the device with a soft, dry cloth.
- Students may not lend the device to anyone.
- While BOGCHS uses technology protection measures to limit access to material considered harmful or inappropriate to students, it may not be possible for the school to absolutely prevent such access, and the Parent/Guardian should supervise the Student’s use of the device at home.
- Devices reported as stolen require that parents notify police to file a report within 48 hours. A copy of an official police report must be provided to the School Administration.
- Students and Parents/Guardians are not to attempt to repair the device. BOGCHS will manage all device repairs. The Student and/or Parent/Guardian must immediately report to School Personnel any damage to or the loss or malfunctioning of the device.
- A replacement fee of \$100 will be charged if the device is lost, damaged or not returned. BOGCHS reserves the right to adjust or waive fees charged for lost, stolen or damaged devices.

Student Section: I understand that it is my responsibility to care for my assigned device at all times and uphold the BOGCHS’s Acceptable Use Policy, Technology Values and Responsibilities both at school and at home. I understand that I will be accountable for my actions and my use of all the resources the BOGCHS provides to me. I will not engage in activities that would be damaging to the hotspot, to myself, or to my peers. I have read and I understand the WIFI Hotspot Use Contract and I agree to follow these rules and guidelines.
